
Yehonatan Indursky The Making of *Shtisel*

A conversation with Yehonatan Indursky, led by Dr. Mashey Bernstein.

Yehonatan Indursky is the co-creator of the popular Israeli TV series, Shtisel, which offers a window into ultra-Orthodox Jews in Israel. Indursky was raised



in an ultra-Orthodox home in Jerusalem and was educated at the prestigious Ponevez Yeshivah in Bnei Brak. In this conversation, the award-winning filmmaker and screenwriter will discuss his Orthodox home, the inspiration for *Shtisel*, and how the series changed his relationship with his home and the Orthodox community. Indursky will be joined by Dr. Mashey Bernstein, who has written extensively on Jewish aspects of the media. Bernstein, an award-winning journalist, has taught at UC Santa Barbara and has chaired the Santa Barbara Jewish Film Festival.
